The USDA Regional Climate Hubs have the mission to develop and deliver science-based, region-specific information, tools, and technologies to agricultural and natural resource managers through USDA and partner programs so that land managers are enabled to make climate-smart decisions. In this solicitation, the Forest Service is looking for projects that will provide syntheses, tools, or best management practices to forest and rangeland managers including the National Forest System (NFS). The objective is for the successful proposals to address a current challenge of forest or rangeland managers whether NFS, State, Tribal, and/or private lands; and for the ability to apply the information on the ground. The final product(s) are expected to be in a form which is usable to forest or rangeland managers and decision-makers.

Proposals must comply with requirements specified in the enclosed RFP. Projects should not be over \$50K. The funding is for a single year, FY17 funds only, and the final product(s) are expected to be delivered by March 2018.
